 - c. Learners can use the space provided on page 4 or use an A3 paper and attach it to the project.

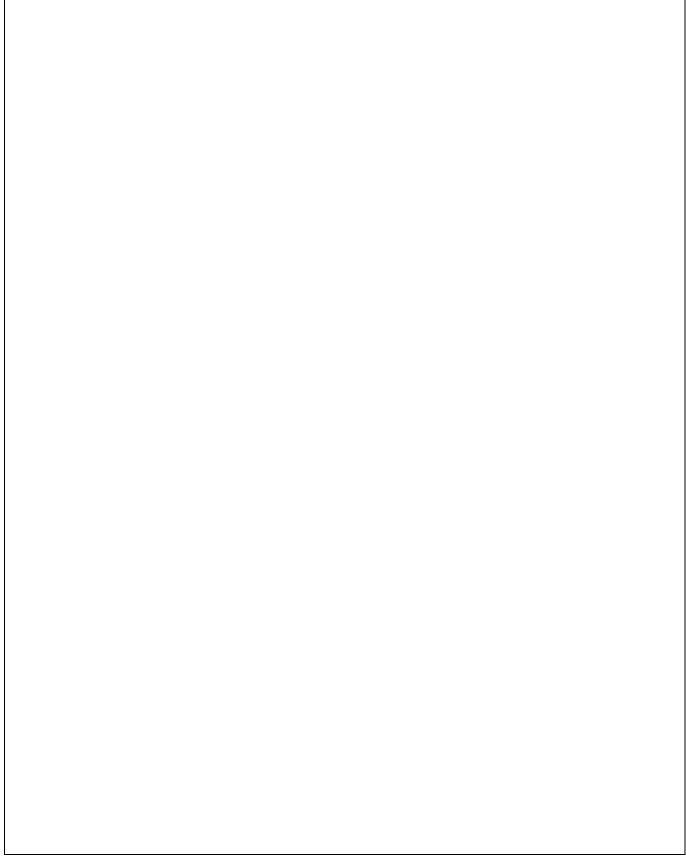
